The Evaluation Report of the First Learning, Teaching and Training Activities That Took Place at the Coordinating School I.E.S. Pablo Ruiz Picasso, in Spain

20.01.2019-26.01.2019

The questionnaire for evaluating the results and the activities of the project first Learning, Teaching and Training Activities was applied on the last day of the project reunion and there were 51 participants who answered.

In this material, we present the questions that the participants answered, which are written in bold, there is an interpretation of results and there are also some of the participants' answers.

1. What have you learnt during this meeting about all partners countries?

The participants have said that they have learnt a lot about the culture, the traditions and the mentality of their partner countries, that for all the partner countries involved in the partnership there is musical heritage that speaks about the country's national heritage that they have appreciated, that they have managed to see that all participants are friendly people with whom they can cooperate successfully and they have learnt words and expressions from all the partner countries' mother tongues.

Some of the participants' answers:

- A lot about the musical heritage of every single country.
- I've learnt to speak English well and also some Spanish. I have learnt what Flamenco is.

- During this meeting I learnt to communicate with other people better and some words of the mother tongues from the countries involved.
- What food they like. What they usually do in their country.
 - About the culture of these different countries.
- That no matter the culture or language that someone has or speaks, you can become friends with all the people.
- I learnt about the different cultures.
 - I have learnt about their culture, their music and their traditions.
- I have learnt about the music of the different countries participating in the program
- I have learnt about the fusion between music and that country's mentality. The coexistence between the elements were very enriching in so many ways.
- I learnt about new cultures, I improved my English and I learned a little of the other languages of the other countries and I know now their musical history and I got to know new landscapes
- I learnt a lot, I learnt that each country has a different culture which is so beautiful.
- I learnt that in the way of music, mentality and other things, countries are different but everything is so interesting and unique.
- I learnt about new cultures, new languages and countries.
- I learnt about the musical history of all countries.
- I learnt about their musical history of all partners countries
- I have learnt many useful things and I made a lot of friendly and funny friends. Also, I learnt how to cooperate with the other students.
- *During this meeting we learned to work together.*
- During this meeting I learned to spend time in a useful way with other people from different countries and to appreciate them.
- I have learned to speak better in Spanish and English and I got to know new people
- I have learnt something about all partner countries. I have learnt that it is very important to always be open-minded.
- We learned a lot of words and that the all the countries have traditional songs.
- *About different cultures and some words of other language.*
- That no matter what mother tongue someone speaks, there is always the language of friendship that the friends from Romania, Spain, Greece, Italy and Portugal speak
- That all of them are great countries with nice people. Their songs are beautiful and we see that nation's mentality in them.
- I learnt about the tradition of another countries. I improved my English skills.

2. Do you think that the five teams prepared the work for the meeting well?

The participants have answered that the five teams prepared the work for the meeting well, the presentations were complete and amazing and they all did a great job.

- Yes, the presentations were great.
 - Yes, they all prepared their materials for the final products properly and followed the steps written in the project.
- Yes, everything was well prepared
- Yes. All the teams have prepared all the materials that were proposed
- Yes, all the countries presented well
- For me, all countries have done a very good and complete work.
- Yes, the work of this project was fantastic, everything was very organized.
- Yes, I found it well done presented.
- Yes, all teams had prepared great work.
- Yes, all teams had presented great materials.
- I think that the teams did an amazing job.
- Yes, I think the 5 teams worked hard and they manged to present their mentality, national identity and traditions in the analyses they had worked on.

3. Do you think that the participants made some progress or achieved some results?

The respondents have considered that they made a lot of progress and they have achieved great results during the interactions of these learning, teaching and training activities. They have raised their cultural awareness, they have learnt about the participants' national and cultural identity and how this identity can be seen in the musical heritage, they have developed their communicative skills, they have improved their English and digital skills, they have learnt how to make friends and to cooperate with people from the other countries, so they developed their social skills, their teamwork and leadership.

- Yes, I do. They have improved their social skills, they have raised cultural awareness, their overcame their shyness in answering and they have coopered to create the 3 finals products.
- Yes. We learnt about traditions, music, civilisations, history and we used English for everything.
- Yes, a lot of progress about the knowledge regarding the 5 partner schools and also in speaking English

4. What exactly did you learn during this project meeting?

The participants have replied that they have learnt many things about the partner countries' culture and civilisations, about the way in which each nation's mentality and history can be seen in songs, the fact that you can learn many aspects about a country through its songs, about the history of music, they have learnt to communicate in English well, they have acquired some words and expressions in other languages, new words in English, some digital skills, they have also learnt to be more independent and responsible and they have also found out what international cooperation is.

- Yes, I was satisfied with all
- I am very satisfied with all. The family was very friendly and nice with me. I am very happy for all.
- Yes, I was satisfied for everything
- Yes, because the host was so friendly, the food was so delicious and my room was beautiful

8. Do you think that the project will make positive or negative development? (E.g. risks, threats, problems as well as chances, opportunities)

The participants have stated that the project will make a positive development because they have learnt so many new things about the partner countries' culture and civilisation, they have improved their skills, they are committed to reach the project objectives, the participants cooperate well and also they will teach their schoolmates, friends and families what they have learnt during this project.
